Engineering/Public Works:

● **Traffic Calming Projects pending data collection:**

- 1) Stevens Road – Pending meeting with work group, met warrants, moving towards letters.
- 2) Twin Palms – Discussed with work group, did not meet warrants.
- 3) Bolero Road – Discussed with work group, met warrants, moving towards letters.
- 4) Cherry Hills Dr – Discussed with work group, did not meet warrants.
- 5) Eastgate Rd – Pending feedback from work group, project on hold.
- 6) Gateway Dr – Pending feedback from work group, project on hold.
- 7) Sonora @ Farrell – Setting up meeting with work group, did not meet warrants.
- 8) Sonora @ El Cielo – Setting up meeting with work group, will install stop sign and crosswalk.
- 9) Cerritos @ Mesquite Ave – Discussed with work group, will install stop sign/crosswalk.
- 10) La Verne @ Caliente Dr – Discussed with work group, did not meet warrants.

● **Other Traffic-Related Projects:**

- 1) Indian Canyon at Rosa Parks Traffic Signal – Going out to bid soon.
- 2) San Rafael at Ave Caballeros Traffic Signal - Going out to bid soon.
- 3) Indian Canyon at Via Escuela Traffic Signal – Included in LRSP for review.
- 4) East Palm Canyon Drive at Rim Road Traffic Signal – Included in Local Roads Safety Plan (LRSP) for review.
- 5) City Wide Speed Survey – Completed, city working on decreased segments.
- 6) South Palm Canyon – Pending road diet and bike lane evaluation through the general plan.
- 7) Racquet Club and Via Miraleste – Design phase.

● **City Building Projects and Other Projects:**

- **Demuth Park Restrooms** – Construction has started.
- **Desert Highland Park Restrooms** – This project is being built by same contractor doing Demuth Park Restrooms.
- **Playground equipment resurfacing** – Measure J has approved the additional funding for the resurfacing of the playground equipment at Victoria Park. Demuth Park resurfacing is complete and Desert Highland Park resurfacing is well under way.
- **Acoustics at the Pavilion** – Pending plans and approval from building and safety.
- **Ballfield light LED conversion** (design funded) – Design to be completed in March for April bidding.
- **Demuth Community Center AC and Emergency Exit**– Project awarded, pending PO.
- **Three Highway Safety Improvement Projects (HSIP), Traffic Signals.** – HSIP 7 under construction HSIP 8 is out to bid. HSIP 9 in design.
- **Traffic Management and signal equipment upgrade project.** – Staff has worked with a consultant to identify outdated equipment and necessary upgrades to other traffic signals. A capital project will be identified and funding sought in the approval of the 5-year CIP. Project is on hold pending installation of equipment by CVAG.
- **Pavement Project.** – **\$6million** Annual Pavement Rehabilitation Project should be completed in March.
- **Slurry Project** - \$1 million Council authorized the project for bid last Thursday.
- **Palm Canyon Pedestrian Safety Projects.** – Projects on Palm Canyon from Tachevah to Ramon include diagonal (“scrambled”) crosswalks at four intersections and new traffic signals. The project is going out to bid soon.

- **Roundabout at Indian/Palm Canyon/Parocela** - Project is in design (30% plans expected next month)
- **Mesquite CV Link** – Sunrise to Compadre – Contractor is planning to mobilize in early February.
