Many Palm Springs neighborhoods use NextDoor as their primary method of exchanging information, issuing alerts, distributing meeting agendas and minutes, initiating and developing social and civic programs, and documenting activities. Its full internet address is *Nextdoor.com*.

NOrg or Norg

Abbreviation for Neighborhood Organization

Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI)

The Palm Springs city office created in 2005 that formalized the process for officially recognizing neighborhood organizations and that continues to nurture new organizations and support established ones. In doing so, the ONI increases opportunities for citizen involvement and enhances partnerships between City Hall and the community. The ONI provides residents with responsive, coordinated services that promote and support collaboration and communication through the recognized neighborhood organizations.

Organized Neighborhoods of Palm Springs

Acronym is *ONE-PS*. The organization was formerly called PSNIC. (Palm Springs Neighborhood Involvement Committee.) It is composed of neighborhood leaders from through the City and meets regularly year-round to address issues, share experiences, learn from the presentations of external resources, and provide a platform for information exchange between Palm Springs government representatives and the community on topics relevant to our neighborhoods and our City as a whole.
